

Commissioned and issued by Stark Community Foundation in August 2017 at the request of the Stark Civic Group, <u>Strengthening Stark</u> is a clear-eyed assessment of the current economic and social health of Stark County. The data-driven report examines key community issues and recommends specific actions to help reverse downward trends to transform Stark into a growing and more prosperous community.

The report has since spurred a county-wide community conversation which led Stark Economic Development Board to create and implement a county-wide economic development plan.
