Paradox Prize

In early June, the Fund for Our Economic Future, the National Fund for Workforce Solutions, Greater Cleveland Partnership, The Lozick Family Foundation and DriveOhio launched *The Paradox Prize* — a public call for big ideas that help Northeast Ohioans stranded economically by their geography connect to tens of thousands of open positions.

Funders anticipate investing up to \$1 million in funding and technical assistance to support up to 15 pilots over the next three years. They are looking for ideas from across the region to break the "no car, no job; no job, no car" paradox. Proposals are now being accepted at www.paradoxprize.com.
